

ON THE GREEN



Where is a jack placed that has been delivered and comes to rest between the "T" and the ditch? It is placed with the point that is closest to the mat-line 2 metres from the front ditch and on the centre line.

Where is a jack placed that has gone out of bounds through being displaced by a bowl?

If the CoP call for the jack to be re-spotted then it is placed in the same position as a delivered jack that has gone past the "T". However, if there is a bowl/s occupying the re-spot mark then the jack will be placed as close to the mark as possible, keeping in line with the centre line and with its nearest point as close to the 2 metre mark as possible without touching the bowl/s that are occupying the spot. It may be that this spot might be less than 2 metres from the ditch.
