ON THE GREEN

What happens if a bowl is played out of turn?

The resulting actions can vary depending on the situation. Firstly, the **opposing** skip can stop the bowl and return it to the player to play it in the proper order. If the bowl has not been stopped and comes to rest without disturbing the head, the **opposing** skip has two choices. They can choose to either return the bowl and get back to the correct order of play or leave the bowl where it has finished and have their team play two bowls one after the other to get back to the proper order. If the bowl disturbs the head then the **opposing** skip has three choices. They can leave the disturbed head as it is, have their team play two bowls one after the other to get back to correct order or play; replace the head to its former position, return the bowl and go back to the correct order of play or declare the end dead.

In a singles game though, if a bowl has been played by each player before it is realised that one of them has played out of turn, play in that end must continue in that order.
